Re: **Veterans Day Program**

Dear SCA Parents,

On **Monday, November 11**, we will be conducting our annual **Veterans Day Program**. This event is very important to our school as it allows us to not only reflect on the price of freedom, but also to honor those who have served our country through military service. We want all our students to understand how important it is to follow Scripture and "give honor to whom honor is due."

The program will be held in the **Worship Center at Sherwood Baptist Church** and will begin at **8:30 AM** and **conclude at approximately 9:45 AM** for students in grades K5 through grade 12 (**No school for K3 or K4**). **Student attendance is required and students should be in regular school uniform** unless instructed to dress up for a special part in the program. (**Elementary students should wear their RED shirts for the program.**)

Because of the early start time, **all students will report directly to the church, not the school**. Like a regular school day, students can be dropped off **as early as 7:30 AM** and **should arrive no later than 8:05 AM**. Elementary students need to be dropped off at the front entrance where the water fountain is located. Secondary students need to be dropped off at the atrium entrance on Barnesdale Way.

There will be NO STAR program that day. All students need to be picked up no later than 10:00 AM from the church.

We want to invite all parents, grandparents, and other family members to join us for the Veterans Day Program. Please use the parking areas on Barnesdale Way, Doncaster Drive, Acker Drive and behind the old library. Golf carts will be in operation shuttling individuals from parking areas to the church entrance from 7:30-8:30 AM.

We will be recognizing all of our veterans and active military personnel during the program. We will be introducing these special groups by branch of service near the beginning of the program. Therefore, we are asking that these individuals report to the **Choir Room** at the church by **8:00 AM** that morning so we can prepare for the program. Family members will be able to get their seats in the worship center in plenty of time for the start of the program.

At the conclusion of the program, students will be dismissed from the church for the remainder of the day. **Elementary students must be picked up in the worship center at the platform**. The secondary students will be dismissed at the Barnesdale Way entrance.

We want to thank you in advance for helping us make Veterans Day a memorable day as we honor those who have helped preserve our freedom. We look forward to seeing you on November 11.
