Semester Exam Policy

At the end of each semester, three half-days will be set aside for final exams for high school students. Exam blocks will be approximately 100 minutes in length. Final exams will be required in four core subjects: Math, English, Science, and Geography/History/ Government/ Economics.

A student may exempt one exam if he/she has at least a 95 as a cumulative average from the beginning of the semester before honor points are added. A student may not exempt the same subject twice in one year. If an AP student opts out of his/her AP exam, then that will count as his/her exemption. If a senior has a college class that does not give a cumulative exam, then that will count as his/her exemption.

Study guides for final exams will be handed out to students at least **two weeks** before exam week. Senior exams in the second semester will be 2-day exams to accommodate regular schedule days. Final exam grade weight will be **15%** of a student's semester grade.
