The purpose of the Official Plan Amendment application is to: • Increase the maximum permitted Floor Space Index (FSI) from 2.5 to 5 • Allow a maximum net residential density of over 140 units per net hectare to no maximum • Permit additional land uses including high density residential The Zoning By-law Amendment seeks to: • Rezone the subject lands to an appropriate zone category • Establish appropriate development standards

If a specified person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of Pickering before the official plan amendment is adopted, and/or zoning by-law amendment is passed, the specified person or public body is not entitled: - to appeal the decision of the City of Pickering to the Ontario Land Tribunal; and, - to be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal, unless in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so. If you wish to be notified of the decision you must make a written request to the City Clerk.

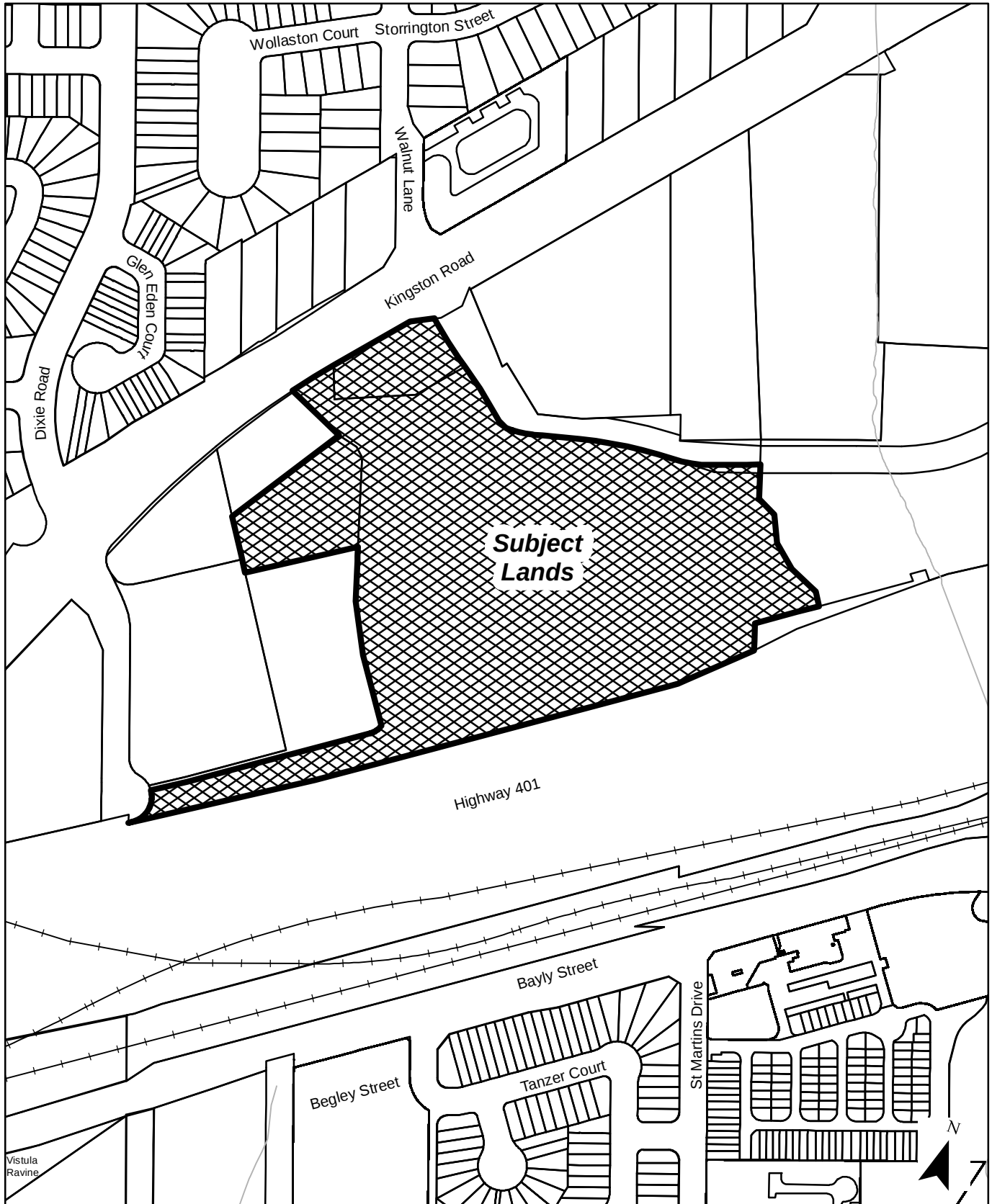

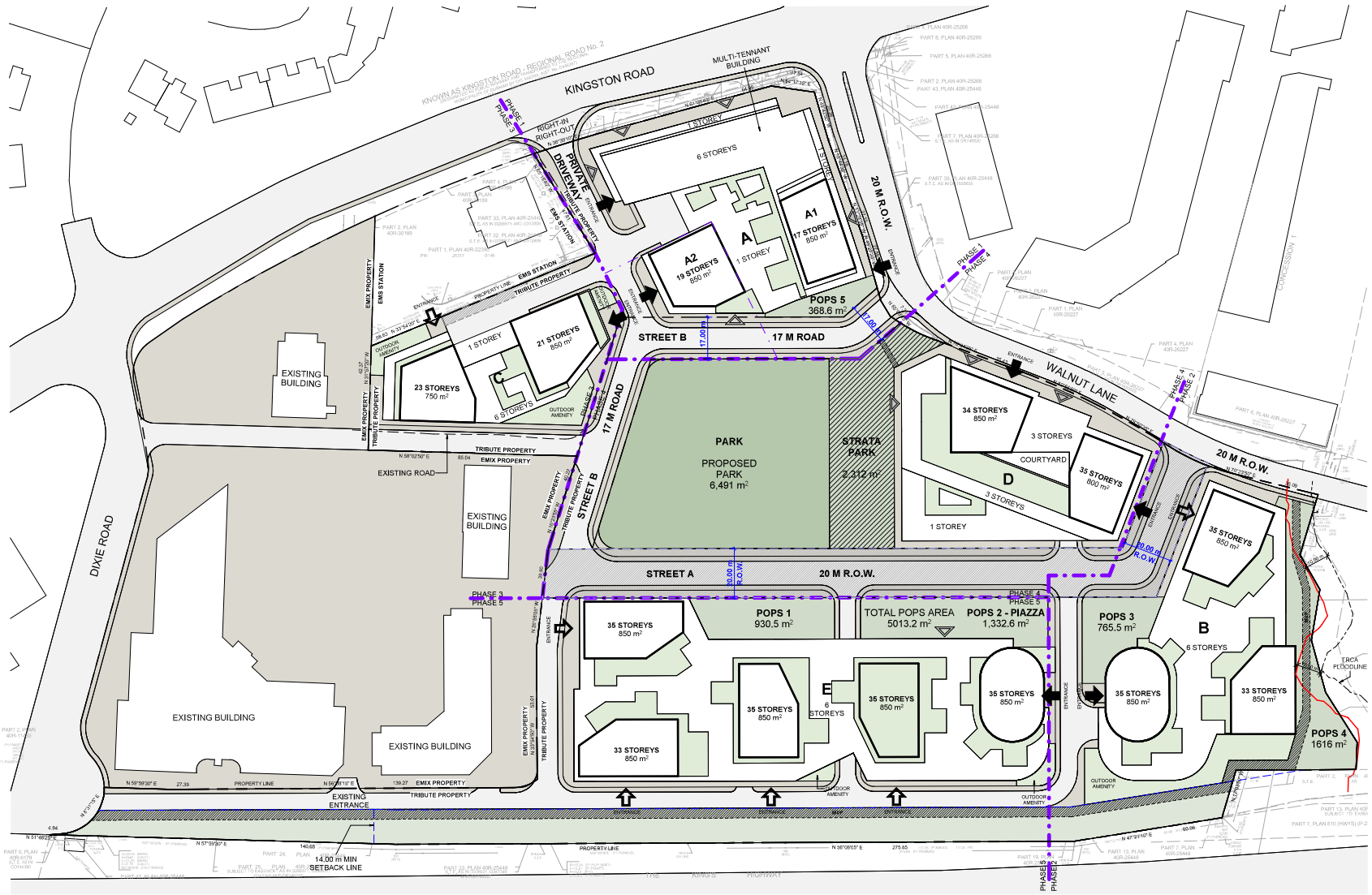
