**You are invited to join us on live stream on Friday evening and Saturday mornings, and we ask that you do not attend in person if:**

- You or anyone in your household has had in the last 72 hours any of the following: fever (100.4 or above), feel warm, have a sore throat, cough, chills, body aches, loss of smell, diarrhea, or vomiting, or
- You or someone in your household had close unprotected contact with a suspected or known COVID-19 patient? (Spent longer than 15 minutes within 6 feet of someone who is sick with a fever or cough), or
- Within the past 14 days you or someone in your household has been sick or diagnosed with COVID-19, or you are sharing a residence with anyone who has been sick or diagnosed or awaiting a COVID-19 test.
