We are now scheduling virtual *Footprints* tours in March & April!

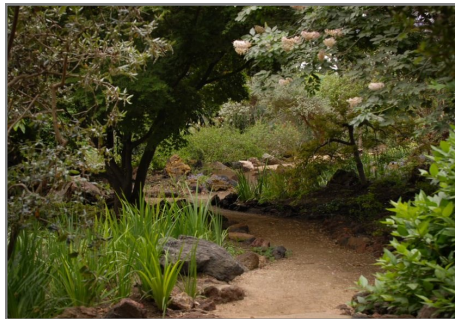
Tour Topics & Schedule
