**We are now scheduling virtual *Footprints on the Land* tours for the fall!**

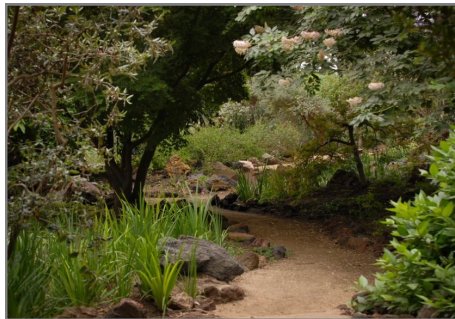
## Tour Topics & Schedule
