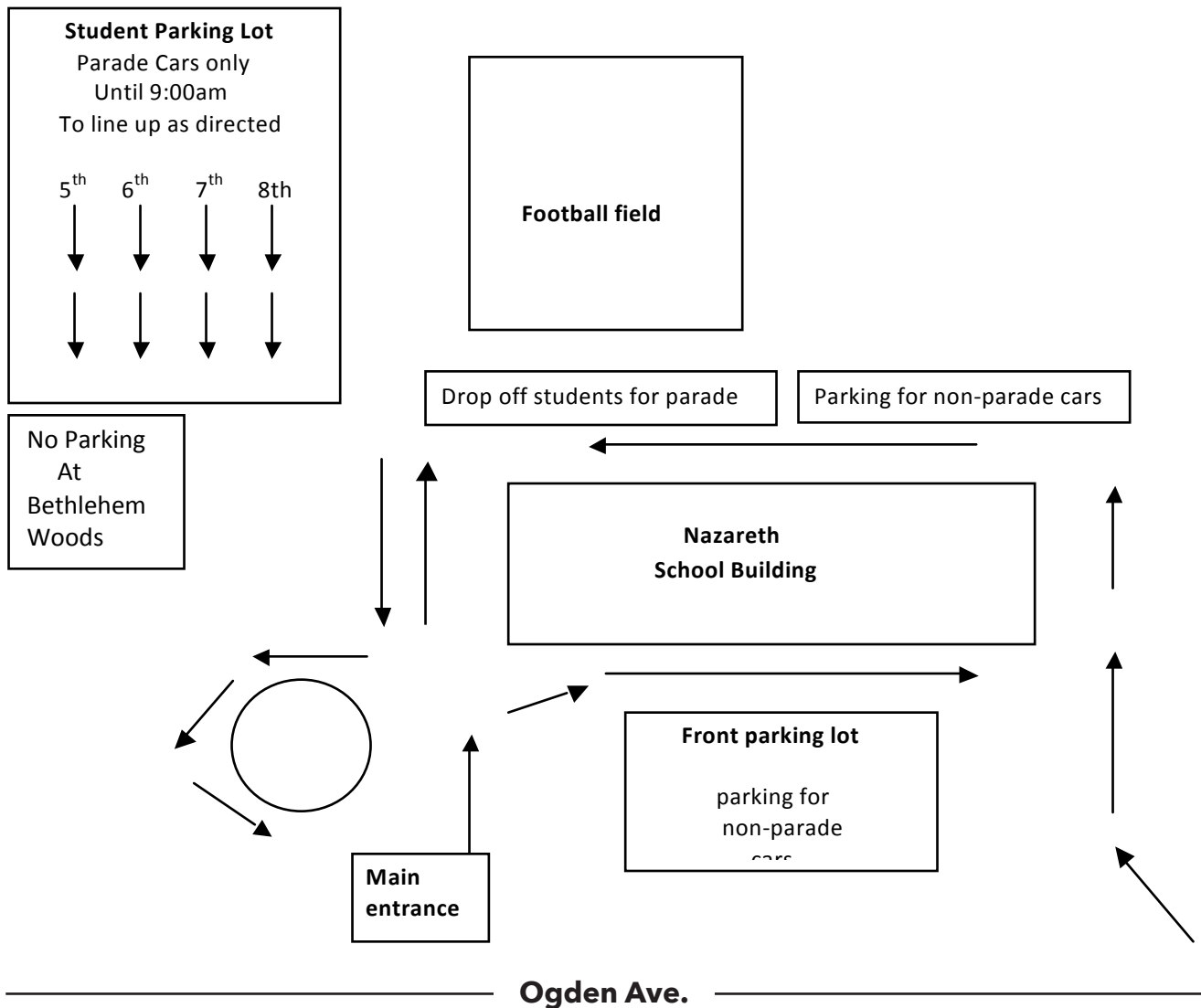

PARADE ROUTE: Exit Nazareth, South on Drexel, East on Hillgrove, North on Spring, West on Bell, South on Brainard, West on 41st, North on Drexel, return to Nazareth



There will be someone standing at the main entrance directing traffic. If you are driving in the parade you will be asked to go straight to the student parking lot. You will be given directions as to where to line up. (Generally, 8th grade teams will be at the front of the parade with younger grades to follow.) If you are just dropping off a student to participate in the parade we will follow the normal Naz traffic pattern. From either entrance off Ogden Ave, travel along the east side of the school building and come around back where you can drop off your student and then turn left and go back out the main entrance. Parking is shown for non-parade cars. If you choose to park on Edgewood or any side streets please be considerate of the neighbors. There will be a lot of excited children running around, please be extra vigilant when driving in the area.

RULES TO REMEMBER

There is no throwing of anything from parade cars (no tp, candy, food, etc.)

There is no standing in parade cars. Everyone must sit or kneel. No unsafe hanging out of car windows. Safety is our #1 priority. Drivers please monitor your riders.

Be respectful of the campus at Nazareth and the neighborhood the parade travels through. Please clean up after yourselves in the parking lot.
