



2019-2020 Tuition Schedule & Policies

Important Note: No family pays 100% of the cost of a Heilicher education. Full tuition covers two-thirds of the actual cost per student. Annual Fund and other fundraising efforts subsidize every student's education each year.

*For Middle School only: Tuition includes fees for multi-day overnight trips (typically to Wolf Ridge Environmental Learning Center in Finland, MN in 6th grade, on-campus retreat in 7th grade, and Washington, D.C. in 8th grade) for a total of \$2,250 spread over three years.

Tuition includes supplies/technology fees (\$250/student for Lower School; \$350/student for Middle School). This covers "back-to-school" items that most schools ask families to purchase and helps support the school's technology infrastructure, including student use of Chromebooks and iPads.

Additional charges may include: meals, transportation, school-sponsored co-curriculars/clubs, and replacement of lost school-provided materials.

Tuition can be paid in full prior to the start of the school year, or monthly by automatic withdrawal from your checking or savings account. **Families prepaying full tuition will receive a \$250 credit on their account for the 2019-2020 school year.**

Continuous Enrollment & Deposit**\$600 per student**

Current students will be automatically re-enrolled for the following school year until they graduate. A Continuous Enrollment deposit reserves a place for your currently-enrolled student on the appropriate 2019-2020 grade-level class roster and will be applied toward 2019-2020 tuition. The deposit will be automatically withdrawn from your Heilicher account on file each February, unless you opt for a deposit installment plan or you notify the school in writing of your intention to withdraw enrollment. **Notice of student withdrawal from Heilicher must be provided in writing to Dean of Student and Family Affairs Julie Ziessman at jziessman@hmjds.org.**

Before-School Care**Drop-in**

Heilicher classrooms open at 8 a.m. each day that school is in session. We offer supervised care at no cost for K-6 students beginning at 7:30 a.m. in the Dining Room. Breakfast items will be available for purchase.
