## **Major Road Construction on Cedar Lake Road Coming Soon**

We have been informed by the City of St. Louis Park that Cedar Lake Road will undergo major road work from early May through August 2019. This work will affect how people get to our campus and how long it may take. We will provide Heilicher families information soon about detours and other options for getting to/from campus during the construction.




Here is what we know right now (subject to change) about the phases of the project:

## Phase 1 - Early May

- o Complete road closure (both ways) on Cedar Lake Road just east of the Quentin Ave stop sign, at the Highway 100 underpass, about half a mile west of us.
- o Cars getting off of Highway 100 N coming from the south (Barry Street Exit), and cars leaving campus for 100 N or 394 W will be affected by backups/time delays.
- o Cars coming from the north getting off 100 S at the Cedar Lake Road Exit or leaving campus for 100 S will be detoured around Wayzata Blvd (see map below).

### DETOUR



- o The city is prioritizing this phase of the project first and hoping to get it done in 2 weeks or less.

## Phase 2 - Late May/June

- o Parkdale/Park Place Blvd/Cedar Lake Road Intersection will be under construction as the city makes all four corners ADA Compliant.
- o Lanes in all directions may be reduced considerably, and rerouting will be possible at times as well.

## Phase 3 = July/August

- o Road Construction on Cedar Lake Road from Zarthan west to Louisiana.
- o No road closures, just occasional thinning of lanes, but still expect travel delays.
