Here's a brief description of the program:

- The Art Adventure coordinator for HMJDS is art specialist, Victoria Thor.
- There are 4 presentations once a month beginning in January and ending in April.
- Parent volunteers attend a training session at the Minneapolis Institute of Art. There are daytime and evening training sessions.
- Each theme has an extensive booklet with very thorough information to make your class presentations easy.
- Cost of the training is \$12.00 is paid through a grant. Volunteers can purchase a set of color postcards for \$5.00 but the set is not necessary for participating in the program.
- We use either a slide set or a LCD projector to view the works during the class presentations. The art teachers will run the technology during presentations.
- Time permitting; there is often a quick art project in class after the presentations.
- Ms. Thor and Ms. Orkin are in charge of planning and teaching these projects.
