The pandemic has prevented us, and many other parishes, from collecting donations and getting them to Hyannis. Bill and Margaret Anne Heuss are our parish representatives to CCCC and have agreed to help us get the donations to the center in Hyannis.

Starting Tuesday morning, September 8th through noon Friday September 11th, there will be a drop off green bin outside the Parish Hall's lower level back door (at the single parking spot by the back door just as the driveway bends to the back lot). It will clearly be marked "A Baby Center".

All donations are to be handled masked and gloved and place them in clean paper or plastic bags.

There will also be a canister of sanitizer wipes you can use to wipe the lid to open and to wipe your hands after.
