

**STAINED GLASS PANELS IN MAIN NAVE
CHURCH OF THE HOLY SPIRIT
ORLEANS, MA**

Gail+ was recently sent material on the small panels of stained glass that are in the center of the windows on the sides of the main nave of our church.


They were a gift in 1989 from Stuart A. Winning, MD, who designed and executed them with the assistance of long time CHS member, Helen Gould Jones, who designed and created the Light House panel. The windows were given in memory of The Very Reverend Paul Roberts, who was the Dean of the Cathedral Church of St. John's-in-the-Wilderness in Denver Colorado for 25 years and a summer resident preacher at Christ Church Harwichport for 40 years. Starting in 1966, Dean Roberts was also a frequent preacher at Church of the Holy Spirit.

Dr. Winning learned the art of stained glass medallions from Dean Roberts who was an acknowledged authority in this art form. See below for a description and picture of each panel and then enjoy looking at them once we can resume worshipping inside the church.

As you enter the nave from the front door, start with #1 – Lighthouse to your right. Then continue up and back around to the other side to back of nave.

8. St. George	Patron Saint of England	
9. Celtic Cross	Symbol of the British Isles	
10. St. Alban	1 st British Martyr	
11. St. James the Greeter	Apostle, Patron of Spain & Pilgrims
