Doris Kearns Goodwin, "**Leadership in Turbulent Times**"

Insightful read about how very differently Abraham Lincoln, Theodore Roosevelt, Franklin D. Roosevelt, and Lyndon B. Johnson handled difficult decisions during their presidential terms. Highly recommend the audio version as the narrators truly "perform" their reading as the presidents.
