

Student Research Assistant Opportunity

Dr. Aisha Yousafzai in the Department of Global Health and Population is seeking a student research assistant to support the LEAPS (Youth Leaders for Early Childhood Assuring Children are Prepared for School) project, an impact evaluation of a youth-led program for early childhood education implemented with government partners in rural Sindh, Pakistan.

The student RA will have the opportunity to work with quantitative datasets with measures for child and youth development collected from household surveys and direct assessments. RA responsibilities will entail data cleaning and quality assurance tasks and support to analysis. There is scope for the work to lead to summer internships, a thesis, and publications.

Successful applicants should be masters or doctoral level students with strong quantitative research and analysis skills demonstrated in coursework or work experience; familiarity with statistical packages; and an interest in early childhood and/or youth development.

Time commitment: 10 hours/week. Beginning November 2019, for a minimum of five months and extendable up to fifteen months.
