



NCSECU members / account holders can get assistance at local branches now through the end of March.

Bring the following, if applicable:

- Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID
- Your log in information (needed to complete the FAFSA online)
- Social Security Numbers and 2022 Federal Tax Return
- Records of child support, cash balances, savings, and checking accounts, and investments


