

Here's a summary of what's going on at St. Paul's:

- The Vestry meeting scheduled for March 17<sup>th</sup> was cancelled due to Coronavirus precautions. Nevertheless, some of the officers offered written reports to the Vestry, some of which are summarized here.
- By the Pastoral Directive of the Bishop, church services through (and including) Easter will be remote/streaming. See attachment for more.
- We are using Facebook Live on Sundays, and then posting the video on YouTube for those without Facebook accounts. This may be extended to other worship services.
- The DOK is exploring having a Skype line for prayer on Sunday after service.
- We are limiting face to face meetings and using conference calls and video meetings (e.g. Zoom). This may include Bible Studies in the near future.
- We're limiting face-to-face pastoral care visitation, and encouraging other means (e.g. telephone, Skype and Duo).
- The Rector began a temporary ministry called 'Match Makers.' It's a way for people with needs to connect those who need help with those who can help. He is currently the point of contact as the match maker.
- We will not have a Fifth Sunday Potluck this month. The next Vestry potluck will be on May 31st. The day falls on Pentecost, and we'll be having a Ministry Faire on that day. At a Ministry Faire, we'll have representatives of the ministries in our church setting up tables (or something to showcase their ministry). This will give the opportunity to highlight our ministries, and let people plug into what we're doing. The fifth Sunday of June 28th falls on the day we celebrate Feast of Saints Peter and Paul. More on that one.
- Duncan Electric will install an electrical outlet on the porch of the school. The Junior Warden will get a set of low-voltage landscape lighting and install it such that the school walkway is lighted when it is dark, and children are arriving or departing.

- The Junior Warden is working on grants and insurance claims for our roofs.
- The new lawnmower account balance is \$3220.00. The Junior Warden has arranged the sale of the existing riding mower for about \$250.00. He will purchase the new John Deere mower soon.
- The Pledge Income for February was 55% of expected.
- The Gas and Electricity bills were higher than budgeted.
- Many of the Parish's costs are fixed costs, and these continue regardless of whether we have regular services or not.
