Protect Your Children, Immunize!

Immunization is the most effective way to protect your children. Follow a schedule of immunization to help prevent these harmful diseases.

Recommended Immunization Schedule	
Age	Vaccine
Birth	Hepatitis B (Hep B)
2 months	Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTaP); Hep B; Haemophilus Influenzae type B (Hib); Pneumococcal disease (PCV); Inactivated poliomyelitis virus (Polio); Rotavirus
4 months	Dtap, Hep B if needed, Hib, PCV, Polio, Rotavirus
6 months*	Hep B, DTaP, Hib, PCV, Polio, Rotavirus
12 months*	Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR); Varicella (VAR), Hib, Hepatitis A
15 months*	DTaP, PCV
4-6 years*	DTaP, Polio, MMR, VAR
After 9th birthday*	HPV
11-18 years*	Meningococcal ACWY; Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)
16-18 years*	Meningococcal B

*Yearly flu shots except for first year when two are needed
