No previous performing experience is necessary, but regular participation is needed. Vocal and choral training are included, along with a lot of fun and camaraderie.



This can be a wonderful opportunity for **those who are new to Canada** to make friends, practise English skills, share music from their culture, develop music skills, learn about other cultures, and integrate more quickly into the larger community. It's also a great way for **established Canadians** to meet and welcome newer arrivals to our community.
