



After Pablo Picasso's death in 1973, his granddaughter Marina Picasso authorized the printing of Lithographs, which have come to be known as the Picasso Estate Collection. These Lithographs were meticulously created after the original works of Pablo Picasso by Master Chromist Marcel Salinas, who worked closely with Picasso in his lifetime.
