Two Czech Companies Expand in Hall County

Two leading Czech electric vehicle component (EV) manufacturing companies, SOPO US and SILENT-US, are expanding their global footprints by establishing operations in Hall County. Both companies produce components for the state's thriving automotive and electric vehicle (EV) manufacturing industry.

SOPO specializes in producing winding wires and magnets for stators and rotors in electrical motors and will invest \$2.3 million and create 25 new jobs. SILENT-US will manufacture insulating parts and components for the electrical industry and plans to invest \$1 million to establish SILENT-US, creating 10 new jobs.

Both companies enter the Hall County market in partnership with ALBAform, Czech manufacturer operated by Monika Vintrlikova and Jan Vintrlik, operating in Flowery Branch since 2013. The family-owned company specializes in custom metal fabrication and assembly of metal components for the automotive, heavy equipment and e-mobility sectors. Vintrlikova, CEO of ALBAform, also serves as Honorary Consul of the Czech Republic in Atlanta. She hopes to build a hub in Georgia through which companies from the Czech Republic can enter the U.S. market.
