For “Methods Monday” in January 2021, Dr. Will Senn will discuss using PRISMA to perform a guided systematic literature review. Dr. Senn is an Assistant Professor of Information Systems and Data Analytics in the School of Business at Emporia State University. He is an Editor of the international journal, *Education for Information*. He holds a PhD in Information Science from the University of North Texas. Will is a member of a multidisciplinary team of researchers in business who are currently looking at data and research involving service quality and satisfaction. His areas of research are in survey measurement, service quality, and information systems.

His topic will be “Moderated Mediation or Mediated Moderation” and will explore the combining the concepts of moderator variables and mediator variables in research.
