## **CHAIN of COMMAND—Go Up!**

**The Elks organization has a structured chain of command to address problems effectively. Here are the steps to follow when facing issues within the organization:**

- 1. Go to the Exalted Ruler FIRST.**
- 2. Next, go to your lodge PDDGER(s) or Lodge Advisor.**
- 3. If there are still problems, go the District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler.**
- 4. The next step is to go to the District Leaders, if the problem has not been resolved.**
- 5. If the problem still has not been resolved, you will need to go to the Sponsors in the California-Hawaii Elks Association.**
- 6. You never start at the top. If you do, it will be sent down the Chain of Command to your Exalted Ruler. (See No. 1 above)**

**Elk Members, there are usually a few ways to submit your payments. You can mail a check for \$138, which covers the total dues. Additionally, there are options to contribute to various causes like the Major Project, ENF (Elks National Foundation), Veterans, Scholarships, and Lodge Improvement, which are optional but appreciated donations.
