 - 2 Tbsp graham cracker crumbs
 - 2 Tbsp lemon curd

- 3 Repeat the layers once more, ending with whipped cream and berries on top.
- 4 Garnish with a mint leaf and a sprinkle of graham cracker crumbs.

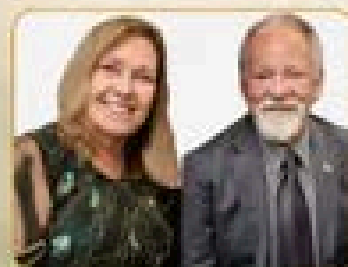
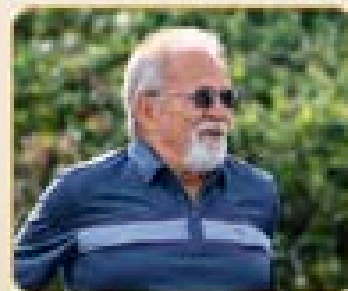
