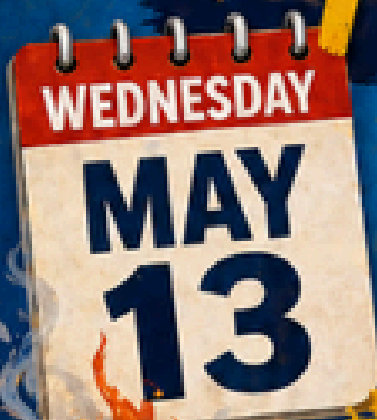

I was born in San Jose, Ca in 1975. I lost my hearing at the age of 2 due a bad case of German measles. I moved to Yucaipa in 1980 and have lived here since. I graduated from Yucaipa High School in 1994. I have also attended college and taken classes in public speaking and computer science.

- 2. Next, go to your lodge PDDGER(s) or Lodge Advisor.**
- 3. If there are still problems, go the District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler.**
- 4. The next step is to go to the District Leaders, if the problem has not been resolved.**
- 5. If the problem still has not been resolved, you will need to go to the Sponsors in the California-Hawaii Elks Association.**
- 6. You never start at the top. If you do, it will be sent down the Chain of Command to your Exalted Ruler. (See No. 1 above)**
