

**What is Orton-Gillingham and Wilson Fundations?
What is the Dyslexia Initiative?**



Orton-Gillingham is an approach to reading instruction for students with dyslexia. It helps teachers understand why it is important to use multi-sensory strategies while teaching students how to understand the structure behind the English language. *Wilson Fundations* is a program for teaching reading, spelling, and handwriting based on the Orton-Gillingham approach.

Fundations is beneficial for all students, and necessary for many.

The Dyslexia Initiative for 2017-2018 includes:

1) Implementation of Wilson Fundations as follows:

- Continuation of Wilson Fundations in K-2 at McPolin and expansion into third grade.
- Expansion of Wilson Fundations in K-2 at Jeremy Ranch, Parleys Park and Trailside Elementary.

2) Opportunity for PCSD Interventionists and Special Education teachers to have comprehensive Orton-Gillingham training.

In addition, the co-creator of Wilson Fundations, Barbara Wilson, is coming to Park City to speak at a **free community event** on October 25th from 6:00 - 7:30 pm at the PCHS Lecture Hall.
