The purpose of the Trainer's EDGE course is to provide and help develop the platform skills of a trainer. It is meant to supplement the practice offered through Wood Badge and NYLT staff development, with a focus on the participant, while raising the level of skill a trainer brings to the staff experience.

While only practice can polish these skills, this course is intended to "train the trainer" on behaviors and resources, while offering hands-on, practical experience in methods and media.

This is part of a continuous process of updating trainers with the latest training methods, principles, and technologies. This course is mainly for Scouters who will be delivering training to adult leaders, as well as to the youth in the Scouting program.

All trainers, including Pack Trainers, are encouraged to participate in a trainer development conference.
