60 VA, MD, and DC middle and high school teams compete at Championship ROBOTICS events Apr 7-8 at EagleBank Arena

FIRST Chesapeake Robotics District Championship Sponsored by Booz Allen Hamilton

Fairfax, VA, April 8, 2023: Sixty of the best and brightest middle and high school robotics teams from Virginia, Maryland and the District of Columbia will compete in the [**FIRST Chesapeake District Championship Sponsored by Booz Allen Hamilton**](#) at the [**EagleBank Arena**](#) April 7-8, 2023.

The event is free and open to the public.

[**FIRST Robotics Competition**](#) (FRC) is recognized as the premier international high school engineering challenge. Working closely with teachers and volunteer mentors, student teams have a short period of time to conceptualize, design, build, program, modify and test remote-controlled robots to participate in a competition that changes each year. Teams work with a common core set of parts, but determine on their own how to accomplish tasks. Thus, no two robots are exactly alike.

This year's game, [**CHARGED UP**](#) Presented by Haas, inspires teams to see the potential of energy storage in a new light as they compete in alliances to charge up their communities.

Teams earn points by piloting their remote-controlled robots to create sustainability links in their grid and to engage with their power station.

Approximately 112 FRC teams in DC/MD/VA vied throughout March in [qualifying matches](#) to earn spots in the Championship that will play out at EagleBank Arena. Top performers at the District event will go on to compete at the [2023 **FIRST** World Championship presented by Qualcomm](#), in Houston, TX, April 19-22.

"The **FIRST** Chesapeake FRC Championship is the pinnacle of robotics sports competitions, bringing together the brightest minds from across the region to design, build, and program their own robots", said Scott Turnbull, **FIRST** Chesapeake Executive Director. "The pride and excitement on display is palpable, as teams compete for a chance to represent their school and district at the **FIRST** World Championships.
