CHALLENGES FOR THIS YEAR

- **☑** Follow CDC and local guidelines for the safety of our teams and volunteers
- Realizing this most likely will not be a "normal" season
 - > Develop "event" strategies to celebrate a teams accomplishments while keeping up with current protection and social distancing guidelines. Including group size limits
 - > Keep teams in their own PODs as much as possible
 - Be flexible as state, local and venue guidance changes
- ☑ Masks will be mandatory for any team or volunteer participating in a FIRST Chesapeake-sanctioned event

FRC AND FTC HYBRID EVENTS

- **☑** Teams compete in smaller one-day events
- Limit attending to team members and mentors
- Remote Judging of all awards including Dean's list
- **☑** Majority of volunteering will be remote
- Remote awards ceremony 6pm the Tuesday after teams compete
- Twitch will be used for spectator viewing
 - > No in person spectators other than teams
 - Recordings available on YouTube

- 2 Greater Richmond events, 4 Greater DC events
