The PTO is thrilled to announce an opportunity for you to get embroidery done on your own clothing and accessories. The PTO is partnering with Project Luong to enhance school spirit and provide you with high-quality, customized apparel.

How it works

GARMENT SELECTION

You can choose and bring your own SHIRT for embroidery, including tops for extended family.

COST

Embroidery costs are fixed. The initial price is \$25 per garment for the school StJPII monogram.

CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTION

20% of all proceeds from this service will be donated back to StJPII for the PTO Wish List.

EXCLUSIONS

Uniforms may not be embroidered.
Merchandise may not be worn on spirit days. StJPII may prohibit certain goods from being customized.

ORDER PROCESS

Payment will be made to StJPII; Project Luong will embroider; PTO will return items to the purchaser. Sales will be offered on a limited basis.

Guidelines

There are established guidelines to ensure that only appropriate garments are chosen for embroidery, factoring in color, texture, and style. Items with existing graphics that may not align with StJPII's values will be excluded. The following materials SHOULD BE AVOIDED when selecting items to be embroidered:

- Sheer fabrics: chiffon, organza, and voile
- Thin or lightweight fabrics: silk or lightweight cotton
- Stretchy materials: spandex, lycra, and some jersey knit
- Slick or slippery fabrics: satin and some synthetics
- Highly textured fabrics: terry cloth, fleece, and heavily ribbed knits
- Delicate or fragile fabrics: lace or tulle
- Thin denim or lightweight canvas: while heavier denim and canvas are good for embroidery, thinner versions may not provide enough stability.
