



EUCARISTIC REVIVAL - 3RD PILLAR OF THE PARISH REVIVAL

For the last few months, I have been going over the pillars of the Parish Revival. The 1st pillar was 'To Reinvigorate Worship' which is the importance of taking time for Mass. The 2nd pillar was having 'a personal encounter' with the Eucharist. I discussed how important it is to take advantage of confession and Eucharistic adoration to help fill you up and work on that personal relationship with Our Lord and Savior!

This month, I would like to talk about the 3rd pillar of the Parish Revival, 'Robust Formation.' Jesus invites us all to learn more about Him and our Catholic faith. Most parishes offer small groups that gather regularly to have their faith nourished by Eucharistic teaching and to support one another in their faith. This intimate style of learning will enable you to form tighter connections, learn more about your faith, and at the same time meet people in your parish. Learning from one another is a great way to grow in your faith. Parishes offer learning opportunities through book studies, bible studies, and even parish pilgrimages to Holy places like Lourdes, Fatima, the Holy Land, and the Vatican. Check out the bulletin of your parish and see all the offerings they have for you to learn more about your faith. They usually have studies during the day and at night. At school, we also offer some learning opportunities through our moms and dads club retreats and fellowship nights. We would love for you to join us. .
