



“Mini-Art Club Spring Semester 2025”

It is now time for students in **“3rd & 4th grade”** to consider joining the **“Mini-Art Club”** for the *Spring Semester*. This is an after school club **open to boys or girls** who enjoy making a variety of challenging creative art projects. We meet in the Art Room #209 on Wednesdays right after school until 5:00 P.M. All classes held during normal “open” school days through the semester. The cost is \$ 200.00 per semester-for 9 classes. The first class is Wednesday February 5th and the last class is Wednesday April 9th. I will host our “Bingo Ice Cream Party” on the last club day April 9th! All payments in check must be made out to **“Ronda Stieber not St. JPII or Cash, and are due in full with the “completed registration form” to secure a spot.**

All Students are *encouraged to bring Water only and Snack* then report to the Art Room right after school. I will prepare set up of the classroom at 3:15 and class begins promptly once set up. Note: Limited enrollment a fun, safe, and creative environment.

Students will be walked down to car pool promptly at 5:00 P.M. Please pick up your child on time. Students who have not been picked up by 5:15 P.M. may be charged late fees according to the Parent/Student Handbook. If a student needs to leave earlier, parents may go to the front office to have your child called down for pick up.

The Planned Spring projects are:

1) Navaho Weaving- Students will learn how to weave on a 10” round beaded frame that is pre-strung. A broad variety of yarns in colors of the entire color wheel and neon’s for selection. These are in different textures and thickness as students learn the weaving process and how to create simple shapes to create a beautiful wall hanging. This will take the majority of our class time.

2) Wooden Picture Frame/Sea Shell Collage- Students will cover the top of their frame with beach sand then select large sea shells in a variety of colors to glue to the four corners, center and sides. Next students will fill the space with smaller to smallest shells so full. They will finish by adding mother of pearl chips all around.

...Enrollment is limited - Intensified art techniques/tool usage are taught. Positive behaviors are required for acceptance!
