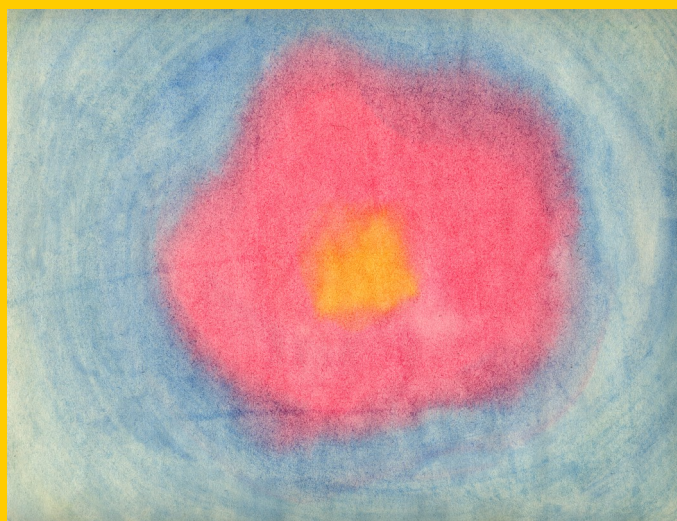

He offers painting workshops in his studio, Windrose. Peter Bruckner was a class teacher for 17 years at the Waldorf School of Camphill Special School. He was the art teacher for grades 6-12 at the Kimberton Waldorf School, from which his three children have graduated. As a landscape painter and teacher, his travels have taken him to Iceland, Ireland, Norway, Switzerland, England, and around the States.
