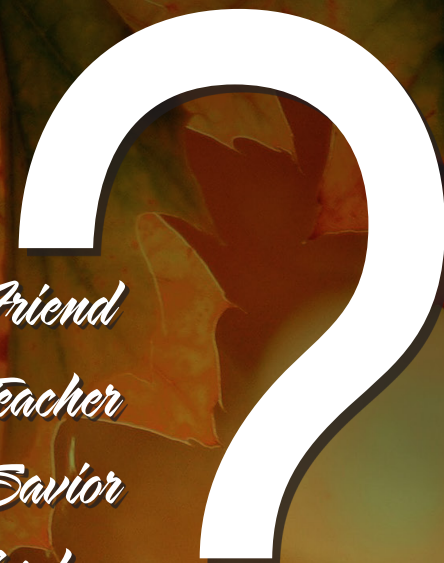

Sunday Morning Worship








Worship services are at 8:30 (traditional) and 11:00 (modern worship) in our newly remodeled Sanctuary. Both services are also livestreamed.

Children of all ages are ALWAYS welcome in worship with their families. Our worship experience is enriched when we gather together as a church family to experience and praise God and learn and grow in faith together.

Family Worship Kits with worship engagement manipulatives are available to guide children and families in worship as they pray and learn about God. The Worship Engagement Shelf has additional worship activities for persons of all ages.

-  The Family Prayer Ground is available near the front of the sanctuary for families wanting a comfortable, close-up view of worship where children and families can experience an unobstructed view of all that is happening in worship.
-  Rocking chairs are available at the Family Prayer Ground and in the Narthex.
-  Nursery care is available in room 18 for children up to age 5. Little ones are cared for in a warm, loving safe and fun environment as they experience God's love on Sunday mornings!

Sunday School for all ages at 9:45

-  Nursery Care/Preschool for children from birth to age 5 will gather in room 18. Young children will experience Bible stories and music in a safe, fun, loving, and caring environment.
-  Children in grades K-5 will gather in room 6. Faith United's Sunday School ministry encourages children to experience the Bible, apply what they are learning in their lives and grow in faith in fun and engaging ways, pending available volunteers.
-  Sunday School Home Activities will be provided weekly in the Sunday worship emails to resource and encourage families.
-  Youth in grades 6-12 will meet in the Youth Room.
-  Faith 101 will meet in the Parlor
-  Adult Sunday School in room 16
-  Adult Sunday School in the Conference room
