TPC

Transition Planning Conference

A TPC occurs between 9 months and 90 days prior to your child's 3rd birthday. At this meeting, your EI Service Coordinator (EISC) can invite anyone you wish to attend so you can learn more about your child's options when transitioning from EI Services. This could include but is not limited to your local school district rep, a Head Start rep, caseworkers, hearing and vision providers, and more!

LEA

Local Education Agency

The LEA will work in cooperation with Early Intervention. The LEA will explain procedures, review records, and collaborate with the family and other team members on what options to consider. These could include a disability not being suspected, monitoring, screening or suspecting a disability. If a disability is suspected, an evaluation plan and evaluation would take place.

IEP

Individualized Education Plan

Following the completion of an evaluation and if your child is found eligible by your local school district, then the next step is to have the IEP meeting where the school will outline the services your child is eligible for and create goals especially for your child's academic success. Your child is eligible to start the discussed services on their 3rd birthday as the school calendar allows.

If you choose not

to pursue an evaluation with your LEA or your child was found to be not eligible for an IEP with your local school district, your EI team can help you explore other options and will continue to provide services outlined in your IFSP until your child turns 3.

If your child has a qualifying diagnosis, they can continue services with WCBDD with our 3-5 program.

3-5 Services

If your child has at least 2 documented developmental delays or they have a qualifying diagnosis, your child can continue to receive services with the WCBDD via our 3-5 services. If you are interested, please talk with your provider prior to transitioning or check out our website to learn more!
