Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Rancho Cucamonga will conduct a Public Hearing on Wednesday, April 2, 2025, in the Council Chambers of the City of Rancho Cucamonga, 10500 Civic Center Drive, Rancho Cucamonga, California at 7:00 p.m., or as soon as possible thereafter, to consider the following:

- 1) a resolution establishing the rates for the impact fees associated with fire protection, park, community and recreation center, library, animal center, police, and transportation facilities;
- 2) a resolution adopting the impact fee nexus studies in support of the foregoing impact fees (the fire protection, park, community and recreation center, library, animal center, and police impact fees are analyzed in a combined impact fee nexus study and the transportation impact fee is analyzed in a separate impact fee nexus study); and
- 3) an ordinance authorizing the development impact fee for fire protection facilities, and other related actions to authorize the above fees; and
- 4) a resolution to amend the Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Major Projects Program.

The City of Rancho Cucamonga's impact fee nexus studies (which contain the data indicating the estimated costs required to provide the services for which the fees are levied and the revenue sources anticipated to provide the services) and a summary of the proposed new impact fees and rate schedule are available for review on the City's website at <https://www.cityofrc.us> and in person at City Hall, front counter, 10500 Civic Center Drive, Rancho Cucamonga, 91730.

All interested citizens are invited to attend the public hearing. Any person may submit written comments to the City Clerk, prior to, or at the time of, the hearing.

The public may attend and comment during the hearing at the Council Chambers. The public may also view the meeting live on the City's website at www.cityofrc.us.

If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues that you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice.
