How We Started

In 1990, Working Wardrobes founder Jerri Rosen felt compelled to make a difference in the lives of domestic violence victims. She and a few friends hosted the first-ever Day of Self Esteem, which served as a life-changing experience for 67 clients from local domestic violence shelters. This event created a foundation upon which Working Wardrobes became a thriving organization, dedicated to preparing thousands annually to re-enter the workforce.

Who We Serve

Since 1990, our independent nonprofit has helped over 119,000 individuals get workforce ready. Working Wardrobes' clients come from a diverse spectrum of circumstances and backgrounds including military service, domestic violence, addiction/recovery, justice involvement, transitional homelessness, and catastrophic illness. Working Wardrobes targets outreach efforts and provides mobile services on military bases and in correctional facilities.


