
Through the Fund, Heritage Conservancy also continues to provide educational programs and in-depth historical research and analysis to a wide variety of individuals and groups. In the past year alone, we have provided historic research assistance and historic preservation presentations to groups in Doylestown, Dublin, Falls, Haycock, Hulmeville, Plumstead, Springfield, Warwick, and West Rockhill. We have also prepared detailed histories for owners of historic buildings in Bedminster, Buckingham, Northampton, Plumstead, Solebury, Upper Makefield, and Wrightstown, along with guidance regarding historic designation status and potential tax credits. This is an important dimension of our work, because our experience is that historic property owners who understand and appreciate the history of their structures put more time and care into preserving their buildings.

Heritage Conservancy was also consulted by a number of municipalities seeking dating and other information about various buildings and structures in their jurisdictions, including: Delaware Township in New Jersey, Lower Makefield, Richland, and South Whitehall townships in Pennsylvania.
