All submissions are to completed and mailed to *William DeVos, Rochester Chapter CSI*Awards Chairman, and postmarked by the stated deadline. Each submission must include all required information, including entry form, and signatures, to be deemed complete.

Deadline Information:

Deadline for all entries is March 24, 2017. The Project Owner, Architect/Engineer, Product representative and Constructor will be recognized for the project, team or individual that best meets the goals of the submission.

Eligibility Requirements:

The awards program is open to Project Owners, Architects, Engineers, Product representatives or Constructors that are members of the Rochester Chapter CSI. **All projects must have been completed in the past eighteen months.**

Awards Presentation:

The Awards Dinner and Program will be held Saturday, April 29, 2017, at the Memorial Art Gallery. The MAG is located at 500 University Avenue in downtown Rochester. - Letters addressing the bid documents/specifications etc., and their influence on the project from the owner, architect, engineer and constructor are encouraged, but not required.
- Comment and evaluation forms shall be completed independently by the Owner, Designer(s), and Constructors. Completed forms may be sent directly to the Awards Chairman (William DeVos) or they may be submitted with the rest of the documents by whoever submits the project.
- Entries will be judged based on the responses to the evaluation forms and the content of the Construction Documents.
