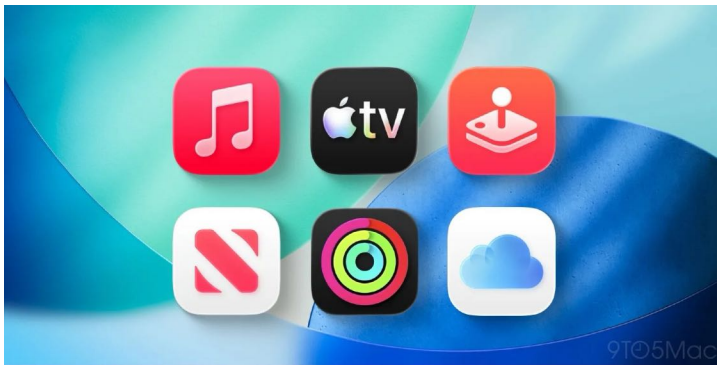

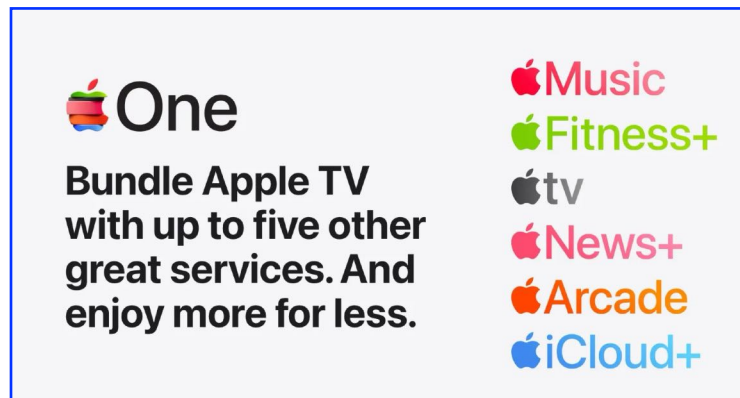

- [Apple Music](#): Apple's streaming music service with access to over 100 million songs.
  - \$10.99 per month
- [Apple TV](#): Access to hit TV shows and movies like [Ted Lasso](#), [Severance](#), [Pluribus](#), and more.
  - \$12.99 per month
- [Apple Fitness+](#): Apple's digital fitness platforms with video workouts across 12 different workout types.
  - \$9.99 per month
- [Apple Arcade](#): A game subscription service with 200+ games, all without in-app purchases or ads.
  - \$6.99 per month

- [Apple News+](#): Access top stories and publications, daily puzzles, in-depth recipes, and more.
  - \$12.99 per month
- [iCloud+](#): iCloud storage, Apple Invites, iCloud Private Relay, My Email, Custom Email Domain, and HomeKit Secure Video.
  - \$0.99 per month (50GB), \$2.99 per month (200GB), \$9.99 per month (2TB)



## Apple One bundles

Apple offers three different tiers of [Apple One](#): Individual, Family, and Premier, It bundles up to six Apple subscriptions for one price.

### Apple One Individual (save \$12/month)

- Apple TV
- Apple Music
- Apple Arcade
- iCloud+ with 50GB of storage

Total if purchased separately: \$31.96

Apple One Individual price: \$19.95

### Apple One Family (save \$14/month)

Share the following services with up to five people:

- Apple TV
- Apple Music
- Apple Arcade

- iCloud+ with 200GB of storage

Total if purchased separately: \$39.96

Apple One Family price: \$25.95

### **Apple One Premier (save \$32/month)**

Share the following services with up to five people:

- Apple TV
- Apple Music
- Apple Arcade
- Apple Fitness+
- Apple News+
- iCloud+ with 2TB of storage

Total if purchased separately: \$69.94

Apple One Premier price: \$37.95

### **Is Apple One worth it for you?**

This question depends largely on which Apple services you find useful. But there are also mathematical equations to take into consideration.

For example, if you're already paying for Apple TV and Apple Music, you should absolutely make the jump and switch to [Apple One Individual](#). Not only will you save on your Apple Music and Apple TV subscriptions, you'll also unlock access to more iCloud storage and features plus Apple Arcade.

I encourage you to look at the bundle options and individual service prices above and run the numbers for yourself and your family. I'd wager that a lot of people reading this story can save some money by switching to [one of the Apple One plans](#). Or, maybe you've been on the fence about subscribing to a new service and the Apple One discount will make that decision easier.

As my colleague Benjamin [pointed out](#) last week, [Apple TV](#) in particular continues to become a better and better value. The service is adding access to F1 and MLS matches at no additional cost next year. If you've been debating subscribing (perhaps for access to [Pluribus](#)), Apple One might make that added subscription easier to stomach.
