## THE SERVICE OF BAPTISM

### THE EXHORTATION

*Celebrant* Dearly beloved, Scripture teaches that we were all dead in our sins and trespasses, but by grace we may be saved through faith. Our Savior Jesus Christ said, “Unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God”; and he commissioned the Church to “make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” Here we ask our heavenly Father that these Candidates, being baptized with water, may be filled with the Holy Spirit, born again, and received into the Church as living members of Christ’s

body. Therefore, I urge you to call upon God the Father, through our Lord Jesus Christ, that of his abundant mercy he will grant to these Candidates that which by nature they cannot have.

## PROFESSION OF FAITH

*Celebrant* Do you renounce the devil and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?

*Candidates & Sponsors* *I renounce them.*

*Celebrant* Do you renounce the empty promises and deadly deceptions of this world that corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?

*Candidates & Sponsors* *I renounce them.*

*Celebrant* Do you renounce the sinful desires of the flesh that draw you from the love of God?

*Candidates & Sponsors* *I renounce them.*

*Celebrant* Almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness and evil, and lead you into the light and obedience of the kingdom of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

**People** **Amen.**

*Celebrant* Do you turn to Jesus Christ and confess him as your Lord and Savior?

*Candidates & Sponsors* *I do.*

*Celebrant* Do you joyfully receive the Christian faith, as revealed in the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments?

*Candidates & Sponsors* *I do.*

*Celebrant* Will you obediently keep God's holy will and commandments, and walk in them all the days of your life?

*Candidates & Sponsors* *I will, the Lord being my helper.*

*(The People stand)*

*Celebrant* Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support these persons in their life in Christ?

**People** **We will.**

*Celebrant* Let us join with these Candidates to proclaim our faith in the words of the ancient baptismal confession, the Apostles' Creed.

*Celebrant* Do you believe and trust in God the Father?

**People** **I do.**

**I believe in God the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.**

*Celebrant* Do you believe and trust in Jesus Christ?

**People** **I do.**

**I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried: He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.**

*Celebrant* Do you believe and trust in the Holy Spirit?  
*People* **I do.**  
**I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.**  
**Amen.**

## LITANY FOR THE CANDIDATES

*(Please kneel)*

*Reader* Let us now pray for these Candidates who are to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.  
**We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.**

*Reader* That all these Candidates may continue in the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers.  
**We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.**

*Reader* That they may walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which they have been called, ever growing in faith and all heavenly virtues.  
**We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.**

*Reader* That they may persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever they fall into sin, repent and return to the Lord.  
**We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.**

*Reader* That they may proclaim by word and deed the Good News of God in Christ Jesus to a lost and broken world.  
**We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.**

*Reader* That as living members of the Body of Christ, they may grow up in every way into him who is the head.  
**We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.**

*Reader* That, looking to Jesus, they may run with endurance the race set before them, and at the last receive the unfading crown of glory.  
**We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.**

## PRAYER FOR THE CANDIDATES

*Celebrant* Almighty and everlasting Father, in your great mercy you saved Noah and his family in the Ark from the destruction of the flood, prefiguring the Sacrament of Holy Baptism. Look

mercifully upon these your servants. Wash and sanctify them through your Holy Spirit, that they may be delivered from destruction and received into the Ark of Christ's Church; and being steadfast in faith, joyful through hope, and rooted in love, they may pass through the turbulent floods of this troublesome world and come into the land of everlasting life, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

*Celebrant*      The Lord be with you.

*People*      **It is right to give him thanks and praise.**

We thank you, Almighty God, for the gift of water. Over it the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation. Through it you led the children of Israel out of their bondage in Egypt into the land of promise. In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John in the River Jordan when the Holy Spirit descended upon him as a dove.

We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we are made regenerate by the Holy Spirit. ## THE PRAYER OF CONSECRATION

*(Please remain standing)*

*Celebrant*  
Holy and gracious Father: In your infinite love you made us for yourself; and when we had sinned against you and become subject to evil and death, you, in your mercy, sent your only Son Jesus Christ into the world for our salvation.

By the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary he became flesh and dwelt among us. In obedience to your will, he stretched out his arms upon the Cross and offered himself once for all, that by his suffering and death we might be saved. By his resurrection he broke the bonds of death, trampling Hell and Satan under his feet. As our great high priest, he ascended to your right hand in glory, that we might come with confidence before the throne of grace.

On the night that he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, “Take, eat; this is my Body, which is given for you: Do this in remembrance of me.”

Likewise, after supper, Jesus took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, “Drink this, all of you; for this is my Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you, and for many, for the forgiveness of sins: Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me.”

Therefore we proclaim the mystery of faith:

*Celebrant and People together*

**Christ has died.**

**Christ is risen.**

**Christ will come again.**

We celebrate the memorial of our redemption, O Father, in this sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving, and we offer you these gifts. Sanctify them by your Word and Holy Spirit to be for your people the Body and Blood of your Son Jesus Christ. Sanctify us also, that we may worthily receive this holy Sacrament, and be made one body with him, that he may dwell in us and we in him. In the fullness of time, put all things in subjection under your Christ, and bring us with all your saints into the joy of your heavenly kingdom, where we shall see our Lord face to face.

All this we ask through your Son Jesus Christ: By him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory is yours, Almighty Father, now and for ever.

*People*      **Amen.**

## THE LORD'S PRAYER

*Celebrant* And now as our Savior Christ has taught us, we are bold to pray:

**Our Father, who art in heaven,  
hallowed be thy Name.  
Thy kingdom come, thy will be done,  
on earth as it is in heaven.

### Invitation to Communion

*This is the Lord's table. All Christians who put their faith in Jesus, have been baptized, are obediently following the Lord's way, and are in fellowship with their neighbor, are invited to receive the bread and wine.*

### To Receive Communion or a Blessing

*Place one hand on top of the other to receive bread. To receive a gluten-free wafer, place one hand on your shoulder and open your other hand. You may consume the bread and drink from the chalice or hold it and carefully dip the bread into the chalice. If for any reason you wish not to receive Communion, or if you have not been baptized, you are welcome to receive a blessing. Simply cross your hands over your chest at the communion rail to receive a blessing in place of the communion elements. \*If you are unable to go to the rail and need Communion brought to you, please alert an usher.*
