After college, she joined the Jesuit Volunteer Corp and was placed with a volunteer program at a hospice for people with HIV. Later, Kathleen received her Master's degree in Special Education with a concentration in Business from Johns Hopkins University.

Kathleen was first drawn to The Arc by her predecessor Steve Morgan. "My predecessor and friend, is one of the most ethical, kind and humble people I know. The Arc Baltimore has a rich history of advocacy and supports that I knew I wanted to be a part of it." While she believes it is too early to think about her legacy, she has big plans for The Arc Baltimore.
