Did you Know?

- Presently, ASPIRA serves over 6,253 New York City youth in 30 schools.
- Nearly all of the students come from low-income households. More often than not, they attend poor performing schools in under-resourced school districts and are first-generation college entrants.
- 100% of students engaged in our Leadership and College Access Program earned a high school diploma; of those, 100%, entered college.

Dr. Antonia Pantoja, ASPIRA's founder, indicated that all those individuals "touched" by ASPIRA are considered ASPIRANTES.

For us, ASPIRA is something more than just an after school club. ASPIRA is a family. All Aspirantes are members of the ASPIRA family.
