Connect: for Adults with Developmental Disabilities and their Caregivers

This program is specifically designed for adults with developmental disabilities and their caregivers. Each month, meet art educators in the Great Hall to explore the galleries on a multisensory tour, then create an artwork inspired by the tour. Due to popular demand, we've added an additional time slot for this program, which will be run by our friends from Visionaries and Voices.

Registration opens one month in advance, and each ticket covers groups of up to 5 people.
