



Native Connections: Cooperative Agreements for Tribal Behavior Health

Overview

The purpose of Native Connections is to prevent and reduce suicidal behavior and substance abuse, reduce the impact of trauma, and promote mental health among American Indian/Alaska Native (AI/AN) young people up to and including age 24. The goals of this program fall within two of the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Strategic Initiatives: *Prevention of Substance Abuse and Mental Illness*, and *Trauma and Justice*.

This program will help grantees: 1) Reduce the impact of substance abuse, mental illness, and trauma on AI/AN communities through a **public health approach**, and 2) Allow AI/AN communities to support youth and young adults as they transition into adulthood by **facilitating collaboration among agencies**.

By June 2022, SAMHSA had awarded 254 five-year grants to eligible AI/AN entities. Twenty Cohort 1 grantees graduated from the grant in 2019, 69 Cohort 2 grantees graduated in 2021, 13 Cohort 3 grantees graduated in 2022, 45 Cohort 4 grantees are entering their fifth year, 26 Cohort 5 grantees are entering their fourth year, 40 Cohort 6 are entering their third year, and 29 Cohort 7 are entering their second year. Twelve communities were awarded grants in 2022, composing Cohort 8. Each Native Connections grantee will be guided through a process aimed at accomplishing the goals of the grant. This process will be informed by the public health model, and a community coalition of stakeholders, which will include youth.

Native Connections Program Goals

- Develop and implement an array of integrated services and supports to reduce the impact of mental and substance use disorders, complex trauma, and to prevent suicide.
- Involve AI/AN community members, including young people, in all grant activities.
- Assess community needs and strengths related to the purpose of the grant.
- Identify and connect behavioral health services organizations that exist in the community.
- Lead efforts to improve coordination among related services for tribal young people and their families.
- Identify gaps and develop a plan that the tribe will pilot in subsequent years of the grant.
- Address behavioral health conditions that affect learning in Bureau of Indian Education schools.
- Use strategies shown to be effective or promising in Native communities.
- Work with SAMHSA's Tribal Training and Technical Assistance Center and SAMHSA's evaluation contractor to develop the infrastructure to collect surveillance data.

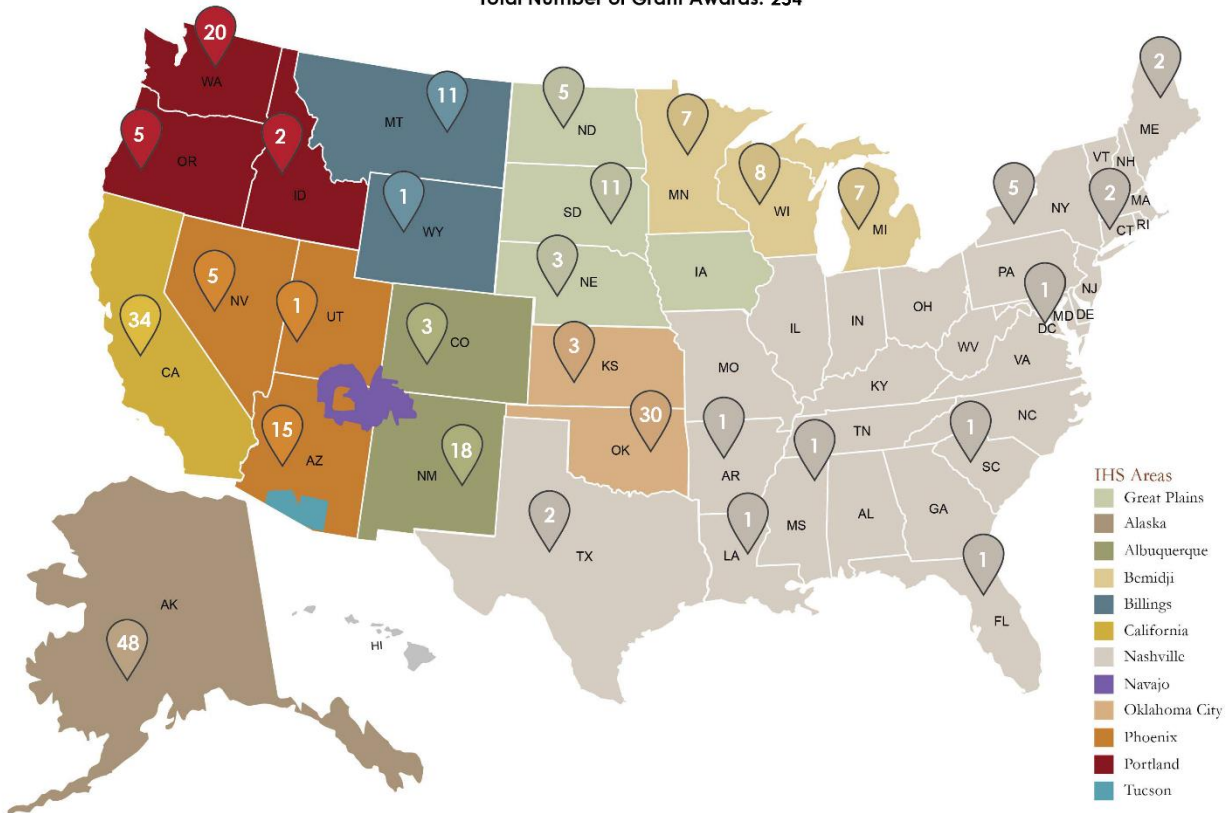

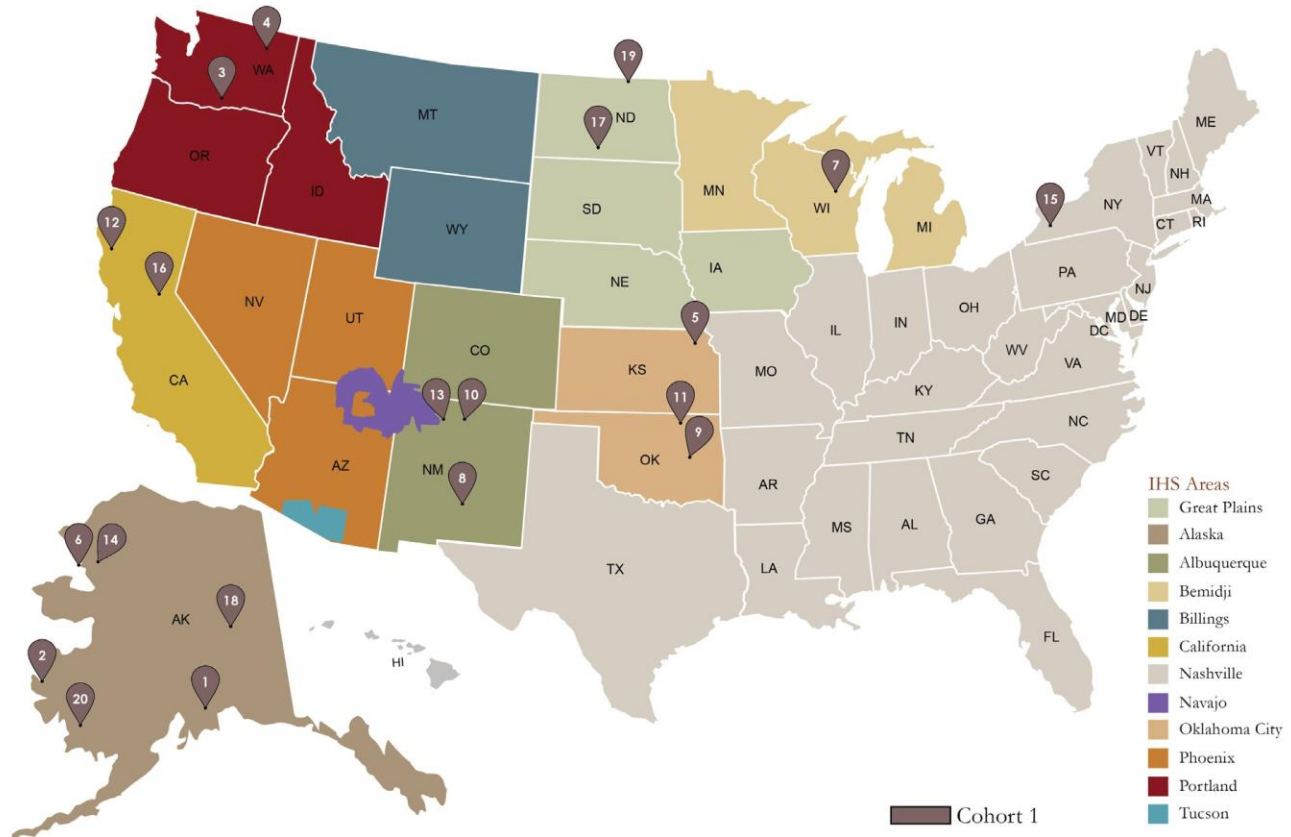

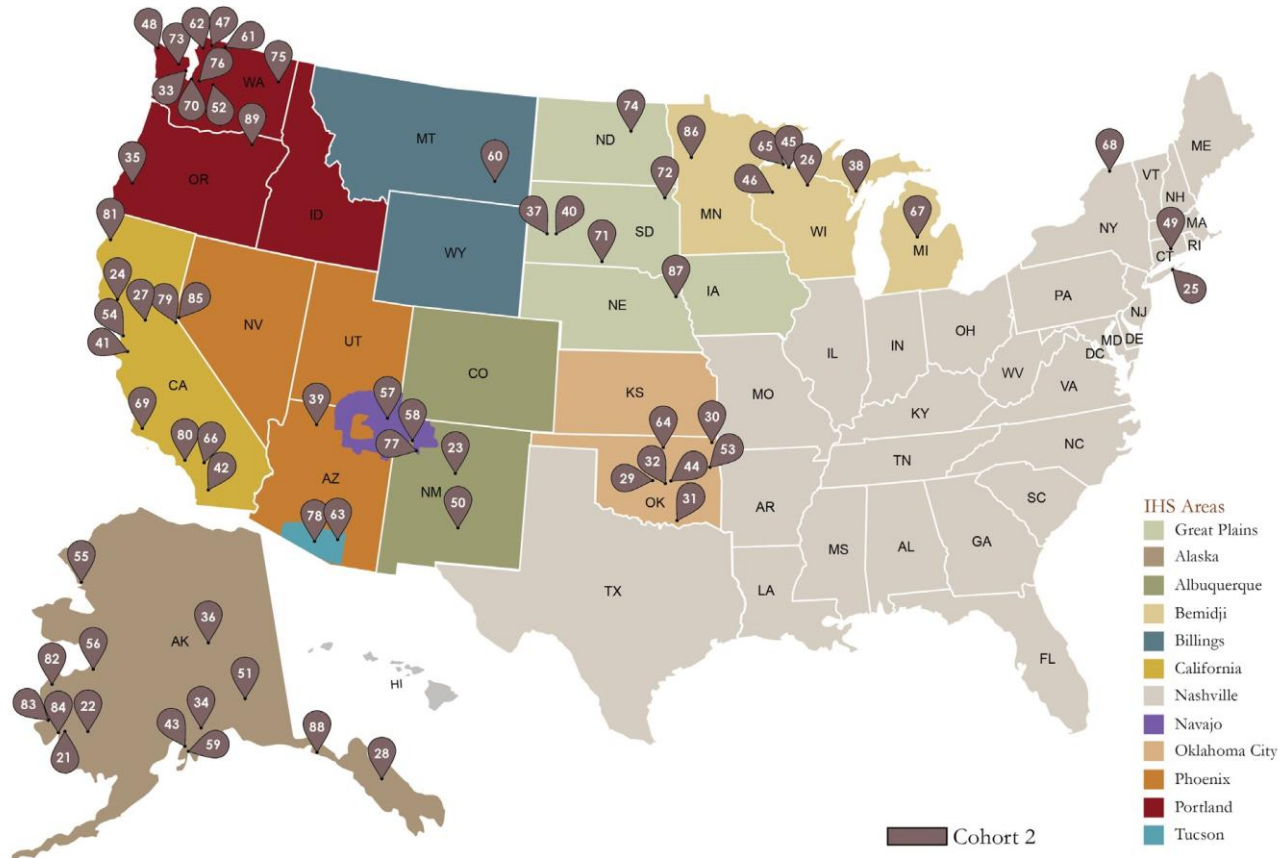

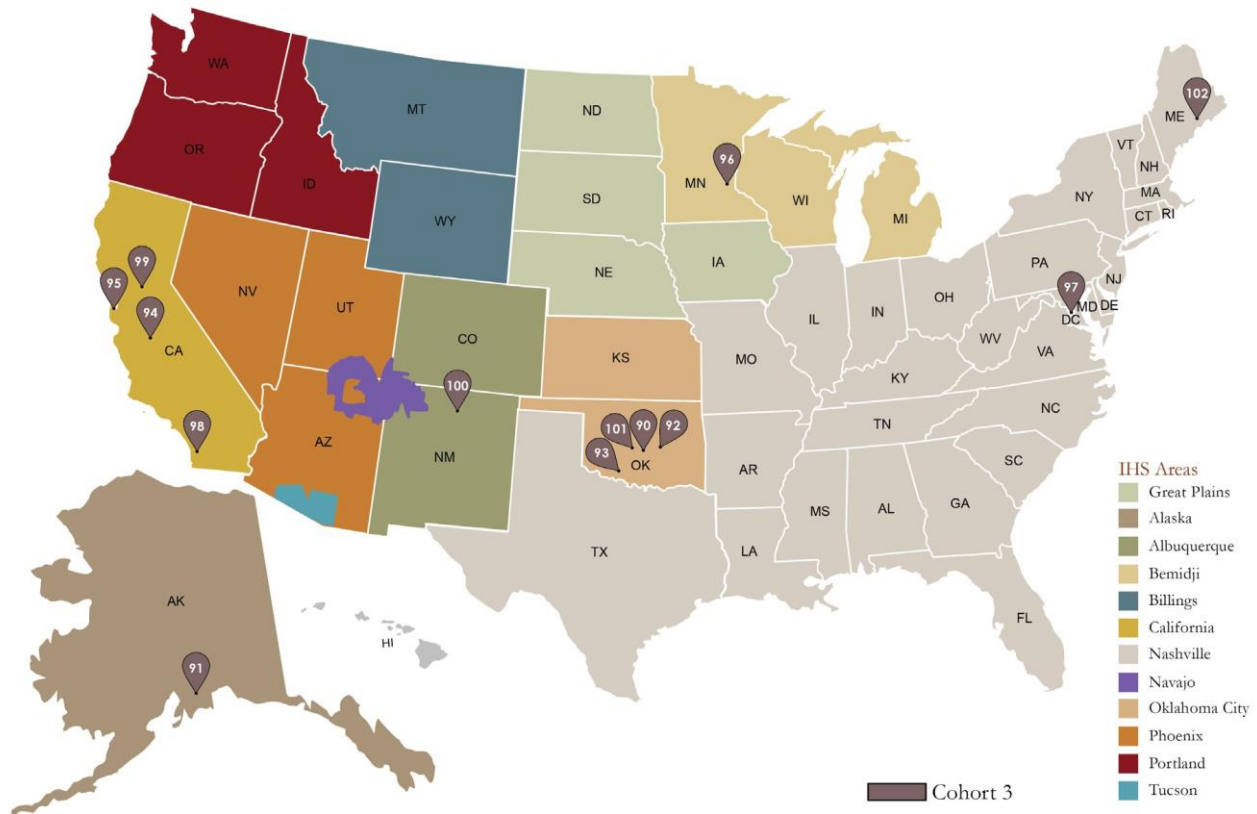

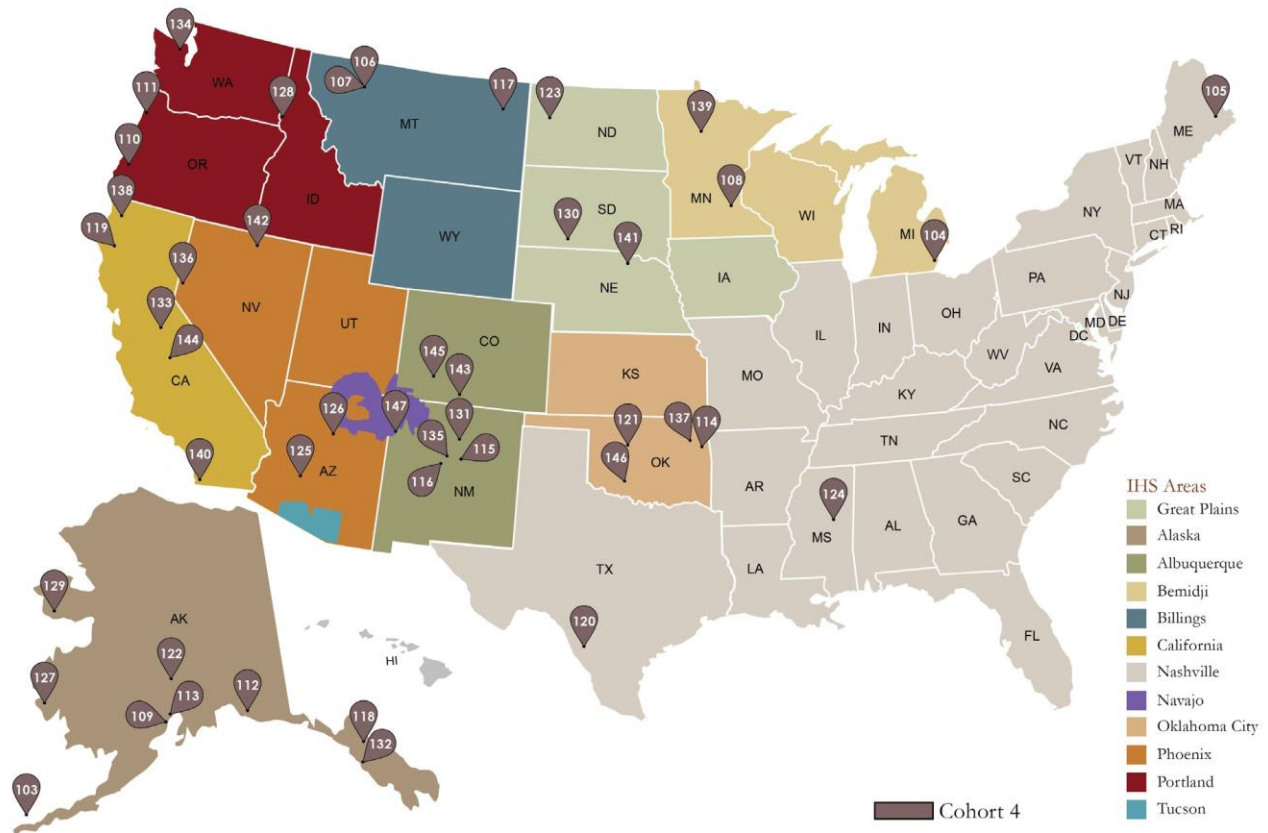

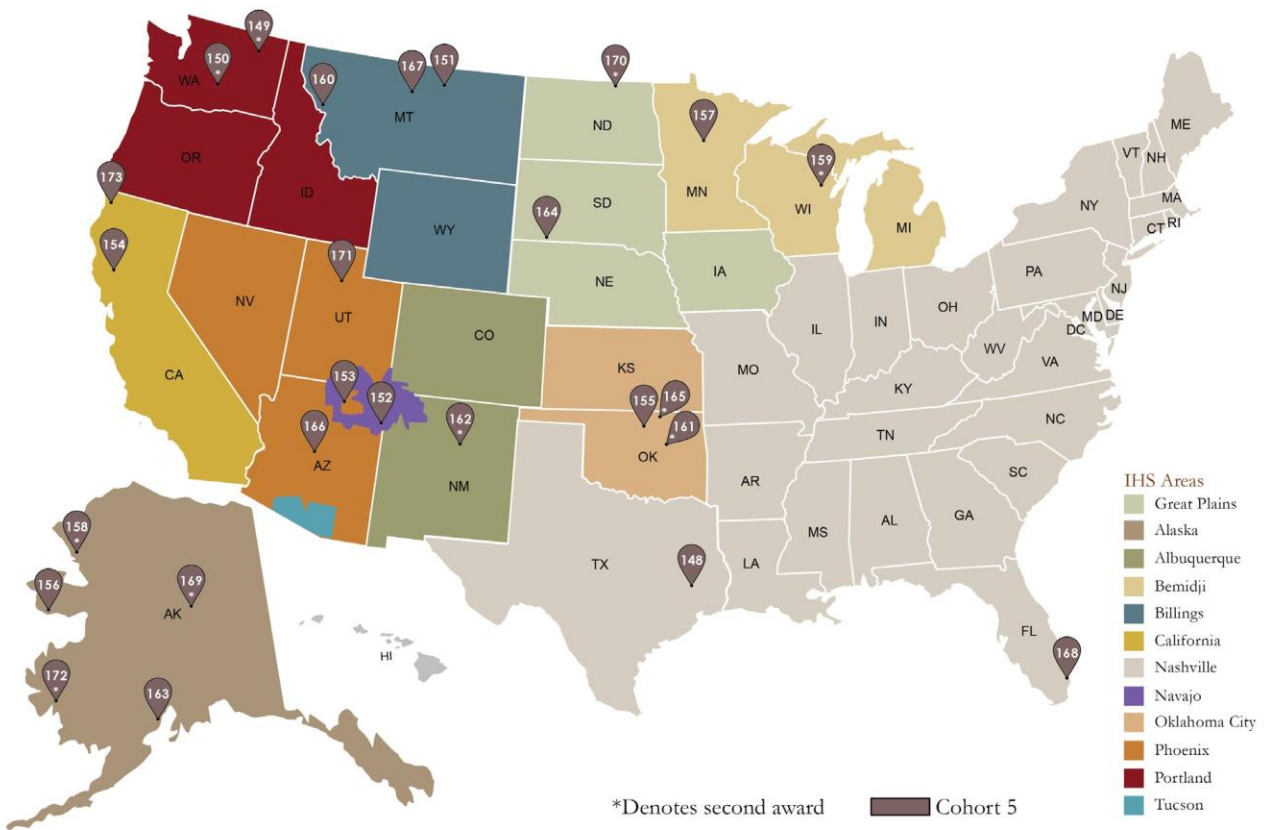

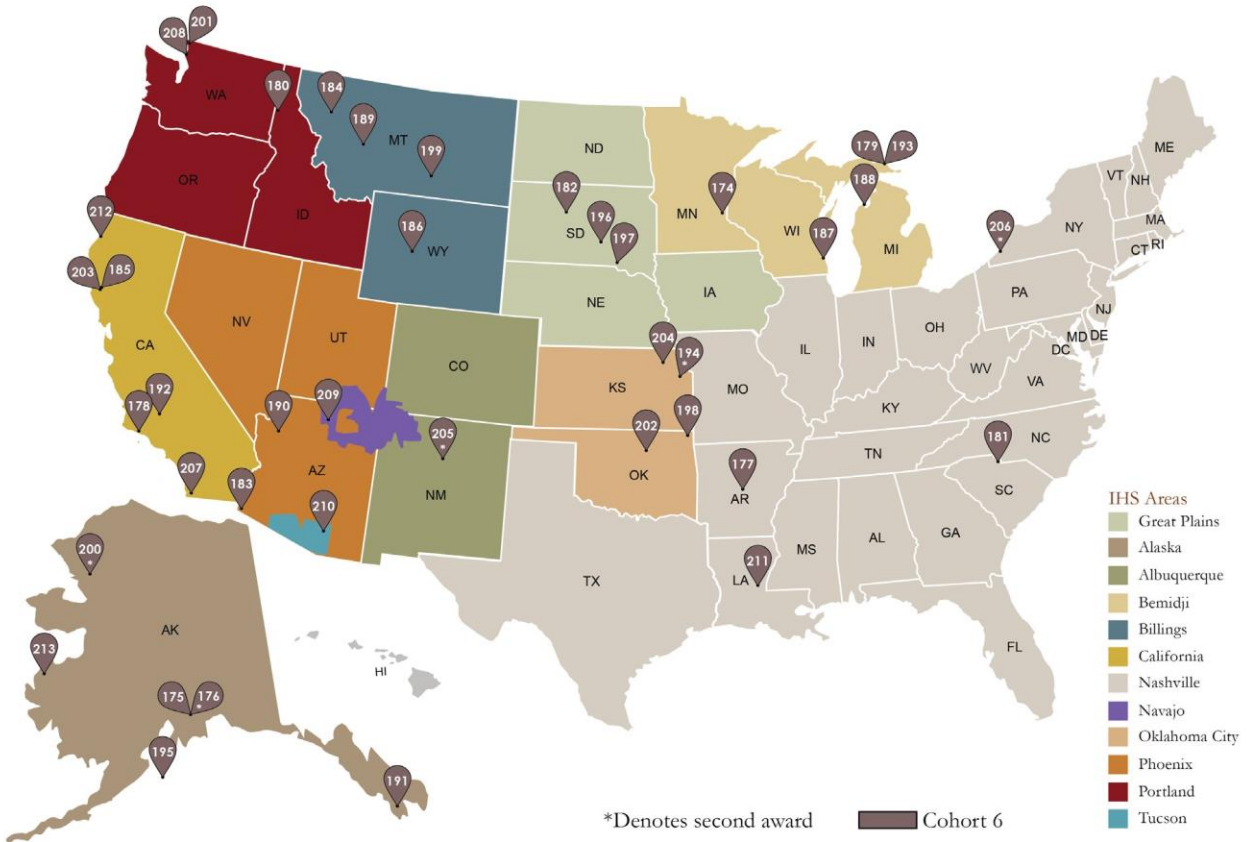

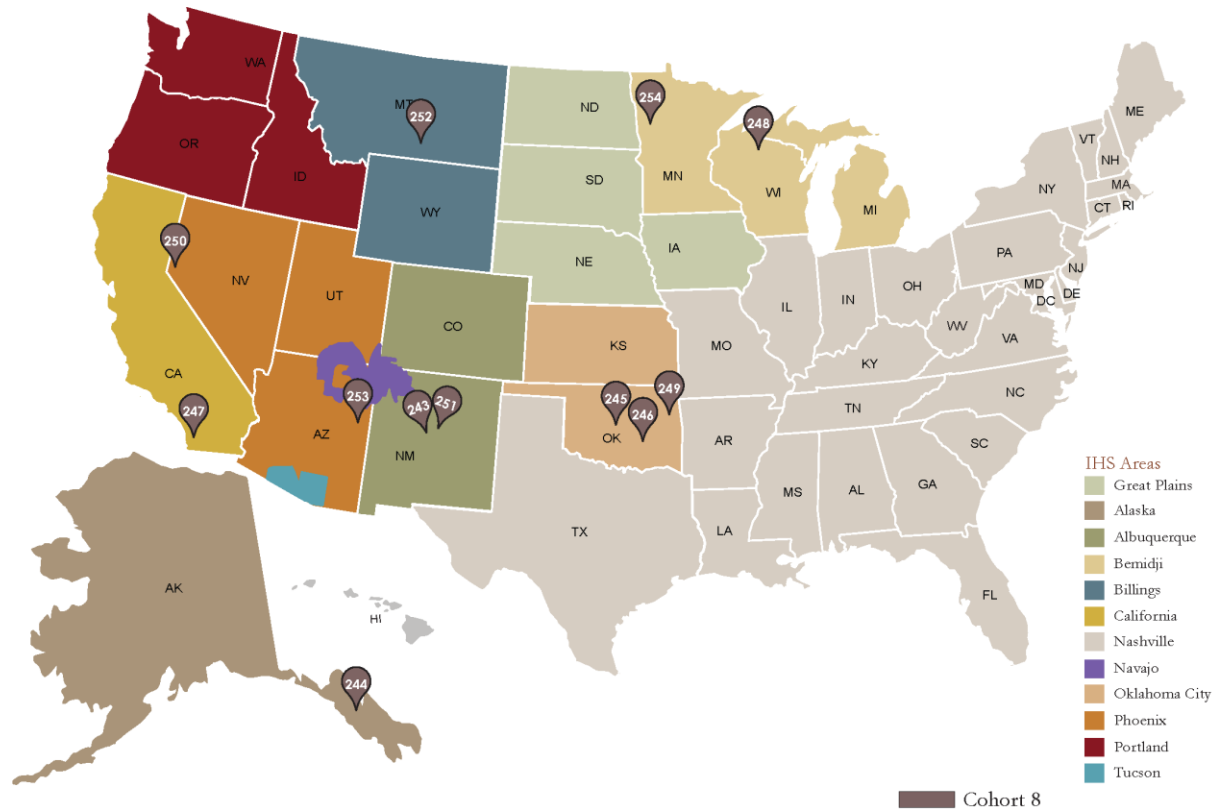
