“When we are affordably housed, we are healthier, and our kids do better in school, and we earn more in our lifetimes; we even live longer. All of that results in not only tremendous benefits to individual people and families but communities and really to our entire country and our economy. That is how we think of it and make the case that housing is healthcare, and again it has never been so obvious as it is now.”

“If we don’t intervene, we can expect the homeless population in LA and across the country to expand. To stop this, we have to make sure that people who got shelter during the COVID-19 crisis stay housed, and we have to help people who are right on the cusp to not fall into homelessness. We are bracing for a huge spike in evictions and homelessness across the country.”

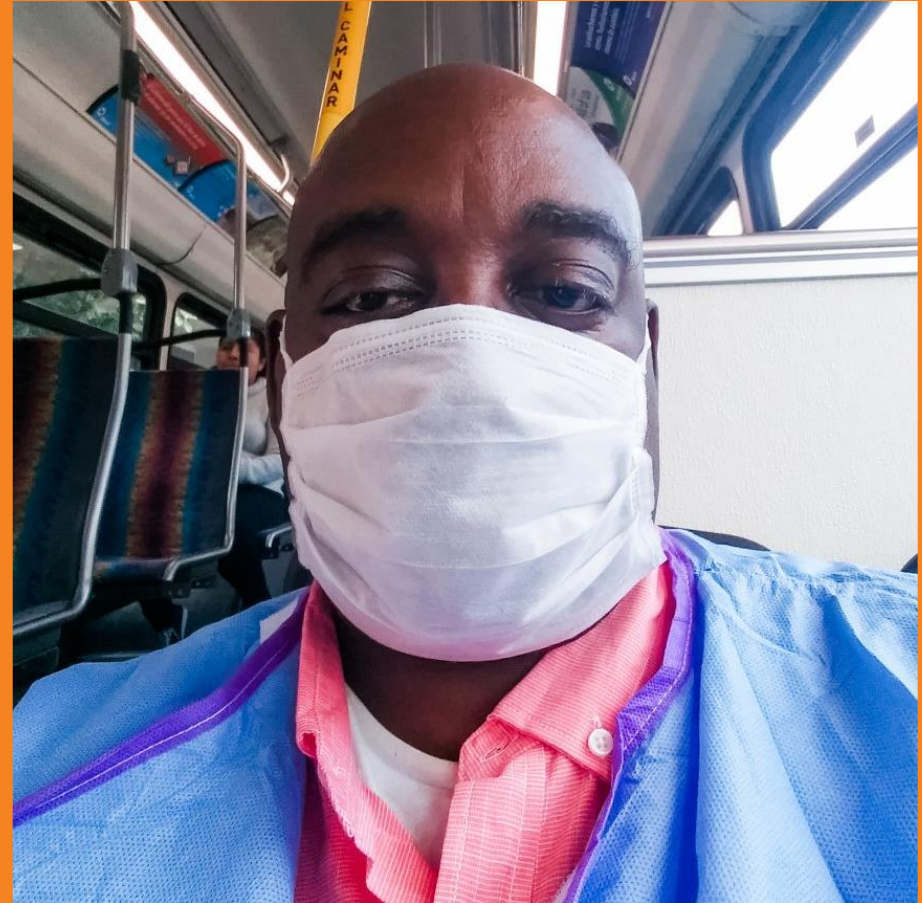

RAYMOND'S STORY



“In 2009, I was a financial aid counselor at a school, and in the financial crisis, I lost my job, and I turned to alcohol. Through my case manager [at the Rossmore], I was able to keep working to address the trauma of my loss.”

“I’m moving from Skid Row to Woodland Hills—I want to say Skid Row Housing Trust, the Case Managers, thank you for keeping us in hope—just because we’re in Skid Row, it does not mean we are out of hope.”

“People should care about Skid Row because when you are in Skid Row, you get stigmatized. It’s easy for people to think that we’re lazy... and that’s not the case, most of us have really suffered, and we just need a hand up—not a hand out. These donations can really change lives.”
