

Catherine Kungu is the Program Development Specialist at the California Department of Housing and Community Development (CA HCD). She is responsible for program development, implementation, and the provision of technical assistance to local governments for programs addressing homelessness. Currently, she is on development team for the Governor's initiative, Homekey. The program will provide \$600 Million for Local Governments to purchase housing for people experiencing homelessness and are impacted by COVID-19. Ms. Kungu led the design and development of the California Emergency Solutions Housing Grant Program and the Homelessness Technical Assistance Program. She also led the initial coordination of the HCFC and was part of the development team for the No Place Like Home Program and the Redesigned Emergency Solutions Grant program. Ms. Kungu serves as the CA HCD's policy content expert on all issues affecting and impacting homelessness around the state.

Prior to her current position at HCD, the Senior Homeless Youth Services Specialist for the California's Homeless Coordinating and Financing Council (HCFC) where she served as the technical expert and provide support in the development of state policies to address issues impacting homeless youth.
