



## **Immanuel Lutheran School & Child Care 2021-2022 Handbook Addendum: COVID**

***This addendum is subject to change in accordance with federal, state, and local guidelines. All employees, students, families and guests of Immanuel Lutheran Church, School and Child Care must be in full compliance with all COVID policies and procedures.***

### **School & Child Care COVID 19 Protocols**

- Building Cleaning
  - Maintenance will be on site at Immanuel from 8:00-3:00 each day
  - Bathrooms will be disinfected during the school day, and deep cleaned once a day after school
  - Classrooms will be disinfected
  - Building/hallways will be cleaned throughout the day
    - Frequent cleaning of touchpoints such as; door handles, light switches, lockers, coat hooks, playground, equipment will occur
- Face masks
  - Immanuel encourages families to choose whether their students will wear a mask while attending school
  - Masks are optional for students, staff, and families
  - All masks should be in compliance with our dress code
  - If your child wears a mask, please put your child's name on the mask in a visible place
- Student becomes sick at school
  - Student will be in the health room until parent arrives to take them home
  - Parent needs to pick up their student within one hour of the school calling
  - Student may not return to school until they are fever free for 24 hours
- Student Hygiene
  - Staff will educate students on the importance of hand washing
  - Students and staff will wash their hands multiple times throughout the day

### **Virtual/Remote Learning Option**

- Immanuel will not offer virtual learning for the 2021-2022 school year

# **WHAT IF SCENARIOS**

## **Fully Vaccinated Students**

If a member of your household tests positive, and you are showing no symptoms of COVID-19 please follow the steps below.

1. Please contact Mr. Amling.
2. Establish when symptoms started with the positive case.
3. From day 3 to day 5 of symptoms starting with the positive case, you should take a COVID test from the doctor.
4. Continue to be home, and wait for results.
5. If you are negative, you may come back to school the following day. We strongly recommend that you wear a mask for the remainder of your 10 and 10 day quarantine
6. If you are positive, you are home for 10 days from when symptoms began.

## **COVID-19 positive family member living in home**

-Student(s) (unvaccinated) who live in the same household would not come to school until the family member that tested positive is symptom free for 24 hours (10 day quarantine). Non positive students would start their 10 day quarantine on this particular day of the positive case being symptom free.

-Educate those students who are at home as if they were home sick with daily work. School work will need to be picked up from the office. Teachers will email or send a ClassDojo message with the homework information.

-Classroom will be disinfected

## **COVID-19 positive student case**

-A positive student may not return to school for 10 days from the time symptoms started until they have been symptom free for 24 hours. Always consult with your pediatrician.

-Modified school work will be given. Virtual learning will not be provided.

-Focus on your students health, over the homework

-Families of the affected classroom will be notified via email by Mr. Amling, but will remain learning in person

-Any siblings living in the same household may not attend school. They are required to quarantine per the above protocol (Positive Family Member Living in the Home) and will receive homework that needs to be picked up from the office

-Classroom will be disinfected

## **Teacher/Staff Case**

-A teacher or staff member who tests positive will not be in the building until the 10 day quarantine period is up and he/she is symptom free

-Parents will be notified via email from Mr. Amling, but classroom will remain learning in person

-Classroom will be disinfected
