BUSING

Every attempt will be made to secure busing to and from away high school athletic events, No busing provided for grade school and junior high athletic events. There is a bus driver shortage in the Twin Cities, and this has affected all schools public and private. We hope to get notification of any bus cancellation the day before the event but sometimes that may not come until the morning of the event.

We are not able to provide shuttle bus service to our practices at Conway Rec Center.

Masks are required while on all charted school buses. This is a state and national requirement. If you cannot comply, you must find your own transportation to and from events.

Bus departure and return times as well as any early dismissal times are located on our Athletic Calendar. You must go to the view schedule are of the calendar and select the sport and then view to see these times. They have not all been entered at this time but should be by the end of the week.

COVID-19 POLICIES

Saint Agnes will not require masks or social distancing while hosting events. There will be several different COVID procedures at away events. The athletic department will maintain a landing page on the athletic website with policies from other schools. Coaches will also share policies from other schools with you via email.

Saint Agnes will comply with other schools COVID policies while at their schools. If you cannot comply with these rules, you will not be able to participate in that event. Some schools will allow those with mask exemptions to participate while on their campus. Those with mask exemptions MUST provide Mr. Streitz a copy of the exemption two days before the competition so it may be forwarded to the host school.
