- Demonstrates the ability to be positive, supportive, discrete, respectful, friendly, easy to talk with, a good listener, courteous, and welcoming.
- Provides emotional support and spiritual companionship to Kaiser Permanente members/patients, their families and loved ones while they are staying in the hospital.
- Conducts an initial spiritual assessment and provides spiritual support as needed.
- Consults with the Hospital Chaplain on complex spiritual care cases/needs.
- After visiting, completes a log sheet for all inpatient visits and reports those visits and findings to the Hospital Chaplain.
- Respects and maintains patient/member confidentiality per Kaiser Permanente policies and procedures.
- Meets Kaiser Permanente Volunteer requirements including appropriate immunity testing (e.g. TB), HIPAA compliance training, background check, and annual compliance testing.
- Completes Kaiser Permanente Volunteer Orientation and Training sessions.
