**Key Responsibilities:** Responsibilities will be shared by team members and may vary day to day.

- Provide excellent customer service with a positive & courteous attitude
- Set-up meal room, count meals, serve lunch and milk
- Play games, read to and do crafts with youth
- Clear and wipe tables throughout meal service
- Ensure program rules are followed by all participants
- Clean up at the end of the mealtime
- Communicate clearly with supervisor

**Time commitment:** At least 1 day/week, each week from June 11 to August 10 from approximately 11:30 A.M. to 2:30 P.M.

**Requirements:**

- Program Orientation (date to be determined)
- Completion of the online food handling certification course. This course is 1-2 hours, paid for by the library, and counts towards volunteer hours
- Completion of all volunteer materials, with parents signature

**Benefits to the Summer Lunch Interns:**

- Real-life job related experience to add to your resume
- Free food safety certification
- Develop soft skills such as teamwork, dependability, communication, and flexibility that can help with employment and college applications
- Earn hours to support school community service requirements
- Meet new people, be a positive role model, spend time with friends
- Free lunch Monday— Friday from June 11 to August 10, 2018 (excluding holiday closures)
